Back by popular demand! The *Maple Ridge – Pitt Meadows School District (SD42)* is once again offering a summer learning opportunity for elementary aged students (grades K-6) currently attending our schools. **(A separate summer learning program is available for children in grade 7 transitioning to grade 8.)** Our mission is to provide engaging learning opportunities that will support your child's long-term development and inspire your child to reach his or her full potential.

PROGRAM AT A GLANCE

Our *Elementary Summer Learning 2017 Program* will follow elements of the provincial curriculum. Emphasis in each of the two programs (grades K-3 and grades 4-6) will be on providing additional experiences in each of the grade areas. Textbooks and worksheets will be set aside as children engage in experiential learning and hands-on activities.

July 5 to July 21

PROGRAM TIME:

9 am to 12 pm

Students will arrive just before 9:00 am, and attendance will be taken in the usual fashion before children begin to rotate through a series of learning experiences. There will be a short nutrition break, supervised by the teacher. The day will end at noon.

ONLINE REGISTRATION will be OPEN from May 1 to May 12, 2017 (noon)

To register your child, visit the Parent Portal at <https://parents.sd42.ca> and look for Summer Learning in **School Upcoming Forms**. Please note that you must be registered on the Parent Portal and have your child linked to your account before you can enrol him or her in the *Elementary Summer Learning* program. This part of the process can be done immediately. Get more information about Parent Portal registration from your child's school.

The program fee is \$50 (this consists of a \$30 refundable placeholder fee and a \$20 for a take home project). You can pay the fee on the parent portal at the end of the registration process, or in person (by cash or cheque or debit)* at Riverside Centre no later than noon, **June 9, 2017**. You will receive an email confirming your child's registration in the program **on Friday, June 16, 2017**. Your child's registration will not be official until you have received this confirmation. *Cheques made payable to SD42.

Attendance Requirements:

The Ministry of Education requires that students must be in attendance for the entire program. Absences due to family vacations or other program commitments cannot be used as a valid reason for non-attendance.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT REGISTRATION - If you are an International Student with SD42, the program fee is \$400. You must register in person at Riverside Centre with payment made via **cash, debit or cheque** (payable to SD42). International Students withdrawing prior to the start of the program are subject to a \$40 processing fee. Refunds will not be issued after July 5, 2017.
