SCHOOL BUS SAFETY RULES

WAITING FOR THE BUS

- 1. Arrive at the bus stop five minutes before arrival of bus.
- 2. Wait until the bus comes to a complete stop before moving towards the bus to go aboard.
- 3. When boarding or exiting the bus, stay in a single file line.

WHILE ON THE BUS

- 1. Stay seated and have your legs in front of you.
- 2. Do not change seats.
- 3. Place your belongings under the seat and keep the aisle clear.
- 4. Talk guietly and be respectable towards other riders.
- 5. Listen to instructions given by the driver at all times.
- 6. No eating or drinking is allowed on the bus.
- 7. No smoking of any kind, including vaping is allowed on the bus.

LEAVING THE BUS

- 1. Hold onto the hand rail.
- 2. Stay at least 10 feet clear of the bus.
- 3. Make eye contact with the driver.
- 4. Look in all directions before crossing in front of the bus.
- 5. Do not walk behind the bus.
