Policy Development

Enrolment Projections

Secretary treasurer Coughlan presented enrolment projections for the years 2017/18, 2018/19 and 2019/20. For 2017/18, it is estimated that regular school age student full-time equivalent will increase by 39 FTE (an increase of 89 students at elementary, offset by a decrease of 50 secondary students). Other projections for the 2017/18 school year include a decrease of 108.0 FTE in Aboriginal Education enrolment. For 2018/19, an increase of 183 FTE school age regular students FTE is projected, continuing to increase by another 221 in 2019/20.

Good News

In the good news portion of the meeting, board chair Murray spoke to the amount of fundraising SD42 students were able to do for the foodbank, and vice-chair Carr acknowledged the hard work of the district facilities director and all maintenance staff during the long stretch of snowy weather.
