## **Alternate Education and Community Connections**

The Board received a presentation on the District's *Keeping Kids in School* (KKIS) program. District Vice Principal Michelle Schmidt reviewed the program's history and highlighted the substantial wraparound services and community connections essential to the program's success. Brenda Donoghue (Child & Youth Care Worker) and Annette McCombs (Senior Aboriginal Support Worker) addressed the ways in which these interventions and support options benefit the individual student.

# Proposed Draft Policies: Whistle Blower Protection and Personal/Sexual Harassment

The Board received the *Whistle Blower Protection* (7110) and *Personal/Sexual Harassment* (7210) policies for the public review portion of the consultation process.
