Full Day Kindergarten presentation

Deputy Superintendent Meston introduced Full-Day Kindergarten committee members Noralea Pilgrim (Early Learning Facilitator), Donna Heikkila and Sheila Pace (Principals) and Monica Stephenson (Teacher). They described the committee's work preparing for and guiding implementation of Full-Day Kindergarten. Their work has included building up a knowledge base on early learning, assisting principals, providing in-service training and mentoring to teachers, and educating parents.

Academic partnership not pursued

Superintendent Unwin reported that district staff had completed research into a possible academic partnership between School District No. 42 and Kwantlen Polytechnic University. The original proposal would have allowed students to start taking university courses while still in high school. Superintendent Unwin reported that there was not sufficient student interest to pursue the idea further at this time.
