

Proposed Preliminary Budget 2017/18

Secretary Treasurer Coughlan presented to the board on the Proposed Preliminary Budget 2017/18. The school district is estimating that \$0.67 million ongoing funding will be available to fund new expenditures for 2017/18 and that an additional \$0.51 million one-time funding will also be available for 2017/18. This will be followed by an estimated budget funding shortfall of \$0.26 million for 2018/19, and \$1.13 million for 2019/20 if the proposed budget changes are implemented.

The board will make its final deliberations and adopt the 2017/18 Preliminary Budget at the public board meeting on April 26, 2017.

2017/18 Capital Plan

The board passed and adopted the Capital Bylaw for the 2017/18 Capital Plan approved by the Ministry of Education.

The board approved a new policy on the maintenance of order in schools; rescinded the International Education Program policy and replaced it with an updated policy and procedure on Educational Programs for Non-Residents; and approved an updated policy on Fees – Hardship.
