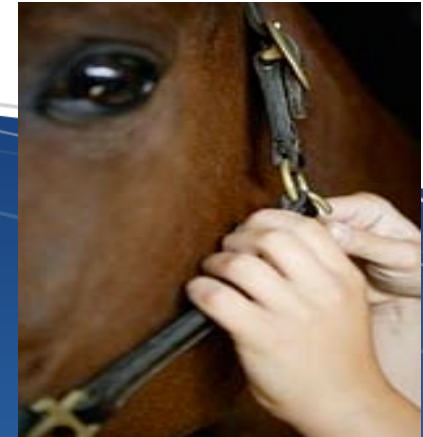

The Academy program consists of four courses: Equine Studies 10, Equine Studies 11, Equine Studies 12 and Independent Directed Studies 12. Students are encouraged to apply before entering their grade 10 year by completing the on-line application on the website.
