Board Meeting Highlights January 24, 2018



Presentation: Secondary Transitions

Learning Services helping teachers Elena Digiovanni and Gary Lozinski presented to the board on how the school district supports students with the transition from elementary to secondary, and how it supports students with diverse abilities with the transition from secondary school into the community. Key considerations that shape this work include how information is collected and shared, and what information and resources are offered to students themselves.

2018/19 and 2019/20 Proposed District School Calendars

Superintendent Russell presented the 2018/19 and 2019/20 proposed district school calendars to the Board of Education. The calendars will be posted to the district website for public feedback from Thursday, January 25, 2018 to Friday, February 23, 2018. The proposed calendars will then be adjusted if required, and submitted to the board for approval at the March 7, 2018 public meeting of the board.

Grade 8 Community-Based Learning Program

Thomas Haney principal Grant Frend and teacher Eira Godfrey spoke to the board about the Grade 8 Community-Based Learning Program, which will be offered at Thomas Haney starting September 2018. Students in the program will divide their time between learning in the school and in the community, with a place-based learning focus on natural spaces such as local parks and forests.

Disposal of Real Property

Superintendent's Update

Superintendent Russell updated the board on school events and activities, and also spoke to the recently released district completion rates for 2016/17. In speaking to the completion rates, Superintendent Russell noted in particular the dramatic increase of completion rates for Aboriginal students, which went up from 69.9% for 2015/16 to 83.5% for 2016/17. Superintendent Russell credited the collaborative effort of the district Aboriginal Education staff, the First Nations community and school staff for the increase.
