

Presentation: School Teams

Assistant superintendent Jovo Bikic presented to the board on the work of school teams in the school district. School teams were established four years ago in the Maple Ridge – Pitt Meadows School District with a focus on the three key themes of inclusion, opportunities for collaboration, and the implementation of the redesigned curriculum. These efforts are guided and supported by Faye Brownlie, Shelley Moore, and Leyton Schnellert, who are pedagogical experts in the field. The work, which has deepened the opportunities for learning, has benefited not only individual schools, but also the school district as a whole.

Environmental School Expansion

The board approved the expansion of the Environmental School from Grades K to 7 to Grades K to 9. Environmental school staff will partner with Thomas Haney Secondary School staff so that Grade 8 and 9 students are able to access curricular and extra-curricular programming at THSS. Environmental School students who complete the program to the Grade 9 level will be offered THSS as their catchment school for the graduation program years – Grades 10 to 12.

Registration Process for Immigrant Students

The board received for information superintendent Russell's presentation on the registration process for immigrant students. Superintendent Russell acknowledged the value of the policy set out by the Ministry of Education, which stipulates that Boards of Education must determine, in a fair and even-handed manner, when a student can be funded for a free public education in BC.
