

Presentations: Project HELLO

Laity View Elementary principal Kristi Blakeway presented to the board on *Project HELLO* – a program designed to **Help Everyone Locate Loved Ones**. Principal Blakeway spoke to the project's history and purpose, and a number of students who had participated in this project spoke to its value and their experiences. Over the years the program has made 750 connections and has had over 500 Maple Ridge – Pitt Meadows School District students participating.

Continuing Education

Continuing Education program staff presented to the board about the history of the program in the school district and the nature of the programming offered through this option. Continuing Education programs include nighttime and daytime high school classes, corrections programs, foundation classes, and the Connected Learning Community (CLC). Students include high school graduates working to meet university requirements, adults returning to meet high school graduation requirements, new immigrants and refugees, as well as international students.

Garibaldi Secondary School International Baccalaureate Middle Years Program (MYP)

Garibaldi Secondary administrative staff and MYP Coordinators spoke to the board about the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Program. Community appetite for this program was identified during the 2015 Strategic Facilities Review process. It was felt that this program would be a natural fit for the school, since Garibaldi already offered the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program. Although the standards are rigorous and applied world-wide, the program is inclusive in nature and is

for all students. A core characteristic of the program is interdisciplinary learning through cross-curricular projects. The school is currently in a candidacy stage, with an external review and authorization visit scheduled for 2021.

The program has been culture builder and a community changer within the school.
