

### **French Immersion Update**

The board received the French Immersion Update for information. School principal and French Immersion program co-ordinator Shelley Linton and district helping teacher Sandra Turbide spoke about the thriving program, which has over 1,653 students (more than 10% of the total student population) enrolled across the school district. Some of the challenges in administering the program – challenges not unique to SD42 – include the recruitment and retention of teachers and the retention of students through the higher grades. French Immersion continues to be a desirable program of choice in the district, supported by several dynamic initiatives such as cultural activities for all schools, four trips to Quebec, and summer camp.
