

Preliminary Budget 2020/21

Secretary treasurer Coughlan presented a summary of all feedback received during the budget consultation process, which ran from April 16, 2020 to April 27, 2020. In total, the school district received six presentations and 22 written submissions on the 2020/21 Proposed Preliminary Budget. Additionally, the online public engagement platform saw 2,400 visitors, with 435 visitors choosing to participate in the budget survey and five visitors engaging through the ideas submission tool.
