Superintendent's Update

Superintendent Russell provided an update on all the work that had been done in the school district since the March 13, 2020 suspension of in-class instruction due to COVID-19, thanking parents, staff, unions and education partners for their hard work and support. Superintendent Russell noted that a return to voluntary, part-time, in-classroom instruction is anticipated for June 1, 2020.

Carbon Neutral Action Report 2019

The board received the 2019 Carbon Neutral Action Report for information. Manager of Energy and Environmental Sustainability Alexandra Tudose noted that the Ministry of Environment has mandated that all public sector organizations report their 2019 actions and projects but report their 2018 carbon data to allow organizations to transition to new carbon emissions software. Energy Management Plan Update

The board also received the Energy Management Plan Update for information. The plan's set target was to save \$500K in electrical costs by 2019/20, and the school district is on track to meet this target. In 2019/20, the targets that have helped the district achieve these savings include lighting upgrades at Westview Secondary, Kanaka Creek Elementary, Arthur Peake Centre, Highland Park Elementary, Golden Ears Elementary, Hammond Elementary, Alexander Robinson Elementary, and the maintenance department. The total investment in all projects has been \$1 million, with resulting ongoing electrical savings valued at \$80,000.
