Trustee Murray spoke appreciatively about the COVID-19 relief funding being distributed to organizations like the local Arts Council and thanked

Superintendent Russell, who announced her retirement by January 31, 2020, for her inspirational leadership and commitment to the school district. Trustee Dumore spoke highly of the district's breakfast programs, reflected on the Salvation Army drive-through Thanksgiving dinner, and looked forward to online Remembrance Day events. Trustee Carreras noted she would be attending the Maple Ridge Community Foundation.
