





SCHOOL-BASED AND DISTRICT-BASED STAFFING








STAFFING FTE BY EMPLOYEE GROUP OPERATING AND CLASSROOM ENHANCEMENT FUND






STAFFING FTE BY EMPLOYEE GROUP AS A PERCENT OF TOTAL






2024/25 OPERATING EXPENSES










FUNDING SOURCE FOR OPERATING FUND EXPENSES






OPERATING FUND EXPENSES BY TYPE
