

Presentation: Kindergarten to Grade 3 Literacy Initiatives

Assistant Superintendent Jovo Bikic provided an overview of the district's coordinated K-3 literacy initiatives, launched following the ministry's March 2025 direction on mandatory early literacy screening. Mr. Bikic highlighted the development of the SD42 K-3 Literacy Guide in English and French, which consolidates effective assessment and instructional practices alongside the new SD42 Kindergarten Screener. He also outlined capacity-building work already underway, including literacy liaisons in every school and training for kindergarten and K/1 teachers. Next steps include exploring Grade 1-3 screeners, deepening the work, and expanding literacy interventions.

Student Advisory Committee Terms of Reference

The board approved the Student Advisory Committee Terms of Reference and directed staff to start the work of establishing the committee. This advisory body will provide a structured venue for trustees to hear directly from secondary students about Student Voice initiatives in schools and across the district, and to engage students on governance topics aligned with the board's responsibilities. Trustees Campbell and Liosis were thanked for bringing the initiative forward. The Terms of Reference will be reviewed annually and can be found in the December 3, 2025, agenda package.

School Growth Plans

Superintendent Downs shared the school growth plans for the 2025/26 school year with the board. The goals identified in the growth plans are aligned with the board's strategic plan and priorities. The committee will examine current funding structures for CommunityLINK, the Equity of Opportunity Supplement, and the National School Food Program. It will develop advocacy strategies and provide recommendations to the board for consideration.

Superintendent's Update: Secondary Schedule Engagement – Response to Recommendations

Superintendent Downs provided the board a verbal update on her response to the secondary schedule public engagement recommendations from the working group.

- Pitt Meadows Secondary, Maple Ridge Secondary, and Samuel Robertson Technical will remain
 on the linear schedule. This decision reflects the majority preference for the linear model based on
 five key criteria.
- Thomas Haney Secondary will not transition to a semester model. Its self-directed learning community relies on the flexibility of the linear model, and a shift could negatively impact programs and opportunities that are central to the school's culture.
- **Westview Secondary** will transition to a semester model beginning in the 2027/28 school year to allow for a thoughtful and well-prepared implementation.

Superintendent Downs noted that school-level data collected make clear that every secondary school and alternate program has important work ahead. Each is expected to review its data, examine existing institutional and structural practices, and identify how it will respond to the needs expressed by students, families, and staff.
