Aboriginal Support Workers assist the Itinerant Teachers for Aboriginal Education by working with identified aboriginal students within schools in the district on an individual or small group basis, and provide guidance and support in order to foster educational success.

The applicant will possess:

- Successful completion of Grade 12 and one year post-secondary education in First Nations Culture or equivalent experience,
- Two (2) years experience maintaining effective working relationships with members of the aboriginal community,
- Good observation skills and the ability to keep accurate notes and records,
- Knowledge of the effects on aboriginal students of cultural differences.

Consistent availability for work five days per week (Monday to Friday) combined with the ability to travel to any school within the District (from Pitt Meadows to Whonnock), is a requirement of this position. This position is casual (on-call) with no guarantee of hours.
