- Ability to work harmoniously and communicate effectively within a work environment requiring a high degree of courtesy, tact and maintenance of confidentiality,
- Successful completion of Non-Violent Crisis Intervention training,
- Valid B.C. Driver's license.

If you can be regularly available for work (Monday to Friday) and are able to travel to any school within the District (from Pitt Meadows to Whonnock), we'd love to meet you. While this position is casual (on-call) with no guarantee of hours, call-outs are steadily available and there are also many opportunities for securing regular positions as you gain seniority.
