UNITED WAY SCHOOLS OUT PROGRAM: CULTURE SHARING AND EXPERIENCE (K-GR. 7)

Encouraging natural curiosity about culture is an essential skill for children in developing an inclusive growth mindset. This Schools Out program begins with a look into what it means to be Canadian and then explores Indigenous-themed content created in collaboration with our local Indigenous communities. Students will then choose five cultures that they are interested in discovering.
