



EDUCATIONAL VISUAL LANGUAGE INTERPRETER

(TIME DURATION)

Located on the shared, traditional, and unceded territories of Katzie First Nation and Kwantlen First Nation, the Maple Ridge - Pitt Meadows School District (SD42) is looking for a qualified Educational Visual Language Interpreter. Under the supervision of the Director of Learning Services and the direction of the teacher(s) of the deaf and hard of hearing, the Educational Visual Language Interpreter interprets between deaf and hard of hearing students and their hearing peers, teachers, and other staff in school and community settings, supporting and reinforcing educational programs. The Educational Visual Language Interpreter will have the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships and work collaboratively as part of an educational team. This is a time duration position, effective September 1, 2022 to June 29, 2023.

The applicant will possess:

- Successful completion of Grade 12 plus a minimum of 3 years Post Secondary education in ASL-English interpreting program, combined with a minimum of 2 years' interpreting experience.
- An awareness of deaf culture specifically and cultural diversity generally, and its relation to students' development and self-perception combined with knowledge of community, provincial and national resources available to students and their families.
- Active membership in the Westcoast Association of Visual Language Interpreters (WAVLI), a commitment to professional development specific to interpreting and a valid BC driver's license.

This is a time duration position effective September 1, 2022 to June 29, 2023, school term. The rate of pay is \$32.72/Hour plus a 4% premium to the hourly wage and 12% in lieu of benefits.
