



LABOURER

Located on the shared, traditional, and unceded territories of Katzie First Nation and Kwantlen First Nation, the Maple Ridge - Pitt Meadows School District (SD42) is looking for qualified applicants who are interested in working as a Labourer and performing manual work requiring physical effort and agility in the performance of routine tasks. The Labourer assists in maintaining lawns and playing fields, installing and repairing fences and playground equipment, moving furniture and equipment, and other assigned duties within the scope of knowledge, skills and abilities required by this position. This is a time duration position effective May 2, 2022 to October 31, 2022, working forty (40) hours per week.

The applicant will possess:

- Successful completion of Grade 10 plus knowledge of materials and methods used in general construction, grounds and maintenance work,
- Sufficient physical strength, health and coordination to permit the performance of heavy manual work outdoors in all weather,
- The ability to operate hand power tools and equipment under supervision,
- The demonstrated ability to communicate effectively and function harmoniously with staff, students, parents, and visitors,
- A valid B.C. driver's license.

This is a time duration position effective May 2, 2022 to October 31, 2022, and follows a 12 month schedule. The shift is 6:00 am to 2:30 pm, Monday to Friday.

Rate of pay is \$23.43/hour plus 12% in lieu of benefits, 40 hours per week.
