The District serves a diverse student population and has developed numerous skilled trades training partnerships with colleges and universities and other innovative programs such as the International Baccalaureate, French Immersion, Academies, Aboriginal Education as well as others designed to support the engagement of all learners in the school district.

As a result of retirement of the incumbent, the District now seeks a new Superintendent of Schools to bring an innovative voice to the school district and to focus on efforts that support its position of central importance to students, families and the communities that the District serves. As the Chief Executive Officer reporting directly to the elected Board of Education, the Superintendent will provide inspirational and strategic leadership to students, staff, parents/guardians, and the community as the Board continues to follow a vision and strategy based on the most current educational research and a commitment to continuous growth and development.

The ideal candidate must possess a Master's degree in Education and has demonstrated a track record of continuous lifelong learning. The candidate will be an experienced and accomplished educational leader with a deep affinity for student success and a reputation for creating and fostering a culture that supports excellence, communication, collaboration, and innovation, and that celebrates diversity.
