



OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST

SD42 is looking for a qualified Occupational Therapist to join our Learning Services Team, for a 0.8 FTE Temporary position, working Monday to Thursday, effective February 9 to June 30, 2026, or until the return of the incumbent, but not beyond June 30, 2026. The Occupational Therapist will work to promote, maintain and develop the skills needed by students to be functional in a school setting, provide services to children with orthopedic, neurological muscular, spinal, joint or sensory dysfunction, as well as those with cognitive and complex neurobehavioral disorders. The Occupational Therapist will provide services that may include assessment, consultation, program planning and assistance in diagnosis, treatment and equipment selection/adaptation. Review reports, interview parents or guardians, observe and assess the learner's needs and consult/collaborate with educational staff and/or appropriate medical personnel.

The applicant will possess:

- A Master's Degree in Occupational Therapy,
- Registration or eligibility for registration and possession of a current license with the College of Occupational Therapists of BC.

The starting annual salary for this position ranges from \$59,711 to \$109,520 prorated to the FTE of the posting, with placement on the range based on length of service and qualifications in accordance with the collective agreement.
