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SCHOOL BUS SAFETY RULES

PRIOR TO GETTING ON THE BUS

1. Students should stay at home if they are sick.
2. Students should ensure to wash their hands with plain soap and water before leaving home in the morning and school in the afternoon.

WAITING FOR THE BUS

1. Arrive at the bus stop five minutes before arrival of bus.
2. Wait until the bus comes to a complete stop before moving towards the bus to go aboard.
3. When boarding or exiting the bus, stay in a single file line.
4. Move to the rear of the bus and take the next available seat.

WHILE ON THE BUS

1. Stay seated and have your legs in front of you.
2. Do not change seats.
3. Place your belongings under the seat and keep the aisle clear.
4. Talk quietly and be respectable towards other riders.
5. Listen to instructions given by the driver at all times.
6. No eating or drinking is allowed on the bus.
7. No smoking of any kind, including vaping is allowed on the bus.

LEAVING THE BUS

1. Hold onto the hand rail.
2. Stay at least 10 feet clear of the bus.
3. Make eye contact with the driver.
4. Look in all directions before crossing in front of the bus.
5. Do not walk behind the bus.
