Prospective candidates for this position must be willing to undergo a pre-screening by Learning Services. This assignment is effective as soon as possible.

The applicant will possess:

- Certification with the Teacher Regulation Branch,
- Successful teaching experience and coursework in special education that includes assessment, adapting and modifying curriculum and teaching students with special needs,
- A Degree or Diploma in special education would be preferred, as would additional coursework in behaviour, learning disabilities, or other specific areas of special education and/or experience working with students with special needs,
- The ability to design, adapt and modify curriculum, write, implement and evaluate positive behaviour support plans and strategies and IEP's, conduct assessment (including level B tests), teach function life skills, collect behavioral and education baseline and progress data, and use technology to support student needs and coordinating and facilitating the work of EA's.
