Located on the shared, traditional, and unceded territories of Katzie First Nation and Kwantlen First Nation, the Maple Ridge - Pitt Meadows School District (SD42) is looking for a qualified Support Priority Teachers Teaching On Call for 1.0 FTE Continuing positions, effective as soon as possible. As a Support Priority Teacher Teaching on Call, you will have opportunities to secure specific Elementary and Secondary Support postings as they become available. You must be available for call-out each working school day of the month and participate in all non instructional days. You will be called on a daily basis by the automated dispatch system or by the teacher on call dispatch desk until you have been able to secure a dispatch at a specific school. As a support Priority Teacher Teaching on Call there may be situations where the District may place you into a position, which you are considered qualified for, and it may be for extended periods of time, if they are unable to fill a current vacancy. Prospective candidates for this position must be willing to undergo a pre-screening by Learning Services. Applicants should have the ability to work as part of a strong collaborative team and have excellent interpersonal, communication and collaborative skills.

The applicant will possess:

- · Certification with the Teacher Regulation Branch,
- Successful teaching experience and coursework in special education that includes assessment, adapting and modifying curriculum and teaching students with special needs,
- A Degree or Diploma in special education would be preferred, as would additional coursework in behaviour, learning disabilities, or other specific areas of special education and/or experience working with students with special needs.
- The ability to design, adapt and modify curriculum; write, implement and
 evaluate positive behaviour support plans and strategies, as well as IEP's;
 conduct assessment (including Level B tests); teach function life skills; use
 technology to support student needs; and to coordinate and facilitate the work
 of Education Assistants.
